Course description and objectives

The PhD in "Legal Sciences" intends to develop a multidisciplinary cognitive path of the evolutionary dynamics of western and European legal systems in particular, in the transition from their traditional reference contexts to those that are emerging in the scenarios of globalized post-modernity. The objective of training jurists who are aware of these changes and capable of facing their challenges in both the theoretical and practical fields, is pursued through two curricular paths, methodologically more than thematically distinct: "People and markets in legal experience"; "History, theory and comparison of legal systems".

The first curriculum favors the methodological approach typical of the positive jurist, declining the two dimensions - individual and collective - "transversal" to the public-private partition.

The second curriculum enhances the tools of comparison, in a diachronic and synchronic sense, stimulating the critical review of the categories and concepts delivered by tradition.

The common training activities will allow doctoral students to compare the two different approaches, enriching their respective knowledge and experience.

Job and career opportunities

Taking into account that the Doctorate aims to train scholars capable of moving easily in the new global law and to prepare highly qualified researchers who correspond to the needs of the world of the legal professions, that of the company and of the institutions, the professional opportunities provided will be above all in the field of top positions - which require high legal skills - in the University, in professional studies and in public and private bodies, at national and international level. .

The training activities provided during the three-year period will also allow research doctors to acquire the necessary skills to be able to address, in the various contexts in which they will be called to operate, the legal problems relating to Big Data.
